**Meeting Purpose and Plan Background**

The purposes/goals of this meeting were to:

- Review each of the Upper and Lower Tier strategies to confirm or modify the screening results developed with city and MPO staff.
- Develop a prioritization of strategies for presentation to the public and preparation of an implementation concept.

**Presentation and Discussion**

Bill Troe led a discussion of each of the strategies that were developed and screened in July with staff from the city and SECOG. This process was started at the July 2008 Providers/Stakeholders meeting, but it was not finished.

The group reviewed each of the concepts and the summary comments provided by URS. Whereas the July committee meeting was a lot more presentation and limited feedback, this meeting was more of a workshop where URS introduced the concept and group discussion of the pros and cons was held.

For the most part, the discussion confirmed the city/MPO screening. Two to three of the strategies that the city/MPO had placed in the Lower Tier were reclassified as Upper Tier because different providers were already providing the service, however, on a limited basis.

The final product of the meeting/workshop was a listing of strategies to take to the public and from which the city, the MPO and URS would prepare an implementation plan/concept for inclusion in the final document.
